

Cesano-Bracciano track doubling

Track doubling on the Cesano – Bracciano stretch, continuing with the already completed track doubling between Rome and Cesano, is part of the work aimed at upgrading and developing railway transport in the Lazio Region.

The aim is to increase the quota of passenger travel on the railway network and to achieve an adjustment to the balance between the various modes of transport to reduce congestion and ensure sustainable development of the territory via improved journey times, quality of service and accessibility of the railway infrastructure.

The project contemplates track doubling, flanking existing for 16 km, between Bracciano station and Cesano Station, eliminating all level crossings and introducing an Automatic Block distancing system.
