

New line upstream of Mount Vesuvio

The new Naples-Salerno link line upstream of Mount Vesuvius is approx. 32 km long and acts, as an extension of the Rome - Naples HS/HC line, as the north/south speed link, freeing the current Naples - Torre Annunziata – Salerno coastal line for exclusively metropolitan service.

The dual track line with its HS/HC features runs from Bivio Casoria, where the branch linking to the Rome - Naples HS/HC line joins with the entrance to Naples Central (HS/HC urban stretch), to Salerno Junction, prepared for eventually continuing further south, from which the interchange point branches out with the Naples–Salerno coastal line.

The scope of the Project furthermore contemplates a new “Vesuvio Est” stop for interchange between the new line at Naples-Salerno and the Circumvesuviana railway, developing the related preliminary design is contemplated for by 2009..
