

# New Bergamo-Seregno line



The new line extends over approximately 34 km, partly flanking the existing Seregno – Carnate –Bergamo line, where the tracks are being doubled. The projected route contemplates track-doubling on site in the stretch, from Seregno to Lesmo (approx. 5 km); the following stretch (approx. 29 km) runs along a modified route, with approx.15 km flanking the future Pedemontana Lombarda motorway. The line terminates at Levate, where it connects to the existing Bergamo-Treviglio line. The line, exclusively dedicated to freight, constitutes the fundamental element in bringing about the strategy whereby freight trains circumnavigate the Milan hub.
